Welcome back to a new season at BYFC and a warm welcome to all new players and their families. This season we are running more teams than ever, in the following age groups

Mixed U7, U8, U9 and U10 teams playing mini-soccer in Royston Crow Leagues on Saturdays and Sundays (U10), and last but not least an **Under 6 soccer club** on Saturday mornings

Given the growth of the club we need to develop our facilities. The 11-a-side teams currently play at the Rec and Bassingbourn Primary School, although there is a danger of over-using the Rec. Those of you who know the school and the Village College will be aware that the pitches are currently of very poor quality mainly due to the rabbits.

We are pleased to be working with the Village College and Primary School on a long term plan to improve the quality of their pitches. This will benefit the children both at school and at BYFC. We hope to start playing 11-a-side at the College in the New Year. We also hope that work on the area behind the swings at the Rec will start soon giving us additional space.
